VILLAGE OF MANORHAVEN - BUILDING APPLICATIONS: WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

If you are putting an addition on your house, tearing down your house, or building a new house...

STEP 1: Submit a <u>building permit application</u> to the Building Department to either approve or deny your application.

- A. If they deny your application because I the drawings are not "to Code" or you need a variance, you will you receive a denial letter. This letter will accompany your application to the Zoning Board.
- If they approve your design, you will receive an approval letter. This will accompany your application to the Planning Board for a Site Plan Review;

STEP 2:

- A. Once you complete the Zoning Board, your next step is submitting an application to the Planning Board for a site plan review.
- **B.** Once you complete the <u>Planning Board</u>, you must submit an application for the <u>Architectural Review Board</u> to review aesthetics of the property, <u>unless directed otherwise</u> by the Building Department (this will depend on the size of the project.)

STEP 3:

Once all Boards have been completed, and you have obtained final conclusions and decisions from each, a completed set of the <u>final approved set of plans and drawings</u> should be submitted to the Building Dept. to move forward with your permitting process.

<u>NOTE:</u> Should you want to subdivide your property, you will need to submit a separate a <u>sub-division</u> <u>application with the Planning Board</u>. This application would take place before all other steps after discussions with the Building Dept.
